## **PLANS OF ACTION**

### **Low Risk**

- 1) Make parent contact. Focus on general mood of student and need for increased coping skills. Provide outside therapeutic resources
- 2) Sign No Harm Agreement
- 3) Parent, if available in person, sign Documentation and agree to remove readily available lethal means for self-harm. Phone contact is acceptable for Low Risk
- 4) Complete Documentation
- 5) Monitor and be available to the student

### **Medium Risk**

- 1) Do not leave student alone
- 2) Make parent contact-include both if possible. Focus on threat of suicide. Give student option of being present for parent contact. Provide outside therapeutic resources. Have parent agree to schedule an appointment.
- 3) Sign No Harm Agreement
- 4) Parent sign Documentation and agree to remove readily available lethal means for self-harm
- 5) Contact OCS if parent(s) do not respond or fail to see severity of situation
- 6) Follow up with student immediately when he/she return to school
- 7) Follow up with parent

### **High Risk**

- 1) Do not leave student alone
- 2) Make parent contact-include both if possible. Focus on imminent threat of suicide. Get confirmation from parent that the student will receive treatment now by outside professionals. Do not simply release a high risk student to his/her parent if they are unwilling to comply with immediate follow-up care. Call 911/Ambulance/Police if necessary.
- 3) Sign No Harm Agreement
- 4) Parent sign Documentation and agree to remove readily available lethal means for Self-harm
- 5) Contact OCS if parents do not respond or fail to see severity of situation
- 6) Complete Documentation
- 7) Follow up with parents the next day
- 8) Follow up with the student immediately when he/she returns to school
